

Safe Haven's 2026 GRAND Challenge

Official Rules & Terms

NO PURCHASE OR DONATION NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. DONATING DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR POINTS OR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

PRIZE FUNDING CONDITION: Except for donated prizes identified in the Prize Schedule, prizes will be awarded only if the Challenge raises at least **\$10,000**, as defined below.

Participation does not guarantee a prize.

1. Sponsor and eligibility. The sponsor is **Saline County Safe Haven Inc.**, doing business as Saline County Safe Haven ("Safe Haven"), **P. O. Box 1100 Benton, Arkansas 72018**. Questions: **s.c.safehaven@sbcglobal.net**.

Eligible entrants are Arkansas residents age 18 or older and businesses, acting through an authorized Arkansas resident age 18 or older. Group or club entrants must designate one representative and one entry name. Any prize won will be delivered to that individual and any division of prize is not the responsibility of Safe Haven in any way after delivery. Safe Haven's directors, board members, employees, and their immediate family and household members may support the fundraiser but may not win. An individual may represent a genuine organization and enter personally, but may not create duplicate or fictitious entrants.

2. Challenge period. Entry and point accumulation begin **October 1, 2026, at 12:00 a.m.** and end **October 31, 2026, at 11:59:59 p.m., prevailing Central Time in Arkansas**. Safe Haven's records control receipt times. The giveaway drawing occurs November 1, 2026; Champion verification and any tie-breaker may occur afterward.

3. How to enter. Make a Donation or Register using the entry form linked at www.scsafehaven.org/grand, provide the requested contact and eligibility information, nominate a minimum of 3 businesses (or individuals) to participate, identify your entrant and any nominator, and affirmatively accept these Rules.

- **Grand Challenger & Grand Ambassador:** Participate through the Donation route or use the free Ambassador form. Participation is available to everyone, equally, regardless of ability to donate.

Both categories have equal access to points and bonus opportunities. Limit **one base giveaway entry per eligible entrant**, regardless of category, number of donations, or donation amount. Changing categories does not create another entry. No nomination is required to join.

Following Safe Haven, posting, sharing, and inviting others are encouraged but optional. Personal-timeline sharing and tagging friends are not entry, point, or prize requirements. Contact Safe Haven before the deadline for an accessible equivalent entry method.

4. Champion points and giveaway bonus entries. An eligible entrant earns **one Champion point and one giveaway bonus entry** for each distinct, eligible new Challenger or Ambassador who completes registration during the Challenge and identifies that entrant as their nominator. The referred entrant need not donate. Each referred entrant may credit only one nominator, once. Self-referrals, duplicate registrations, repeated donations, and larger donations generate no additional credit.

Each participant may credit only one nominator. Once submitted, that choice cannot be changed except to correct a verified entry mistake. Safe Haven may verify identities and referrals. Leaderboards are provisional until verified. Report apparent errors promptly; reporting an error does not guarantee an adjustment or extend the entry deadline.

Additional mini challenges may award points, entries, or prizes only under written supplemental rules published before that mini challenge starts. No bonus opportunity may require a donation or favor donors.

5. Winner selection.

The **Grand Challenge Giveaway** winner will be selected November 1, 2026, by a random generator from all valid base and bonus entries. Each valid entry has an equal chance; odds depend on the total number of eligible entries received. An entrant may win both competitions. Separate mini-challenge drawings follow their published supplemental rules.

The **Grand Challenge Champion** winner will be the eligible entrant with the highest verified Champion point total.

6. Champion tie-breaker: If entrants tie for the highest verified point total, each tied entrant will receive the same instructions and 72 hours from email notice to complete the tie breaker challenge.

7. Prizes and \$10,000 minimum. Subject to the funding condition:

- **Champion:** 2026 Champion title, trophy, community recognition, and a Safe Haven-approved team celebration reimbursed against receipts up to **\$500**. Unused allowance is not payable in cash.
- **Giveaway:** One Hot Springs weekend getaway, maximum advertised value **\$1,000**, plus additional mystery prizes.

Prize Schedule "\$10,000 raised" means aggregate monetary donations attributable to this Challenge and received by Safe Haven or its authorized processor by the Challenge deadline, **before processing fees but excluding unpaid pledges, refunds, chargebacks, processor**

tips, and in-kind gifts. Safe Haven will verify and announce whether the threshold was met within 14 days after closing.

If the threshold is not met, **Safe Haven-funded prizes will not be awarded and no cash replacement is owed.** Donated prizes identified in the Prize Schedule will still be awarded regardless of the total raised. Champion recognition may still be given. The condition applies to every prize component separately and must also appear in prize advertising.

No entrant may be required to donate, cover a fundraising shortfall, or pay Safe Haven to claim a prize.

8. Prize acceptance and fulfillment. Potential winners will be contacted through their registered contact information and must respond within **seven** calendar days. Safe Haven may require reasonable eligibility verification and legally required tax documentation. Failure to respond, ineligibility, or refusal permits selection of the next eligible Champion under these Rules or a replacement random giveaway winner.

Prizes will be delivered or arranged within 60 days after verification unless the Prize Schedule specifies otherwise. Winners are responsible for applicable taxes and expressly disclosed incidental expenses. Prizes are not transferable before acceptance without Safe Haven's consent. If an awarded prize becomes unavailable for reasons outside Safe Haven's reasonable control, Safe Haven may substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Group representatives accept on behalf of their groups; internal distribution is the group's responsibility.

9. Donations and conduct. Donations support Safe Haven's charitable mission and are not purchases of entries or prizes. Failure to win or reach the fundraising threshold does not itself entitle a donor to a refund; applicable law and any accepted donor restriction control. Tax deductibility depends on applicable law and individual circumstances.

Use only authorized donation channels. Entrants may not collect money in Safe Haven's name without written authorization. Fraud, bots, purchased or fabricated referrals, harassment, deceptive claims, unsafe conduct, or interference may result in disqualification after reasonable review.

Never disclose shelter locations, survivor identities, private stories, or confidential information. Obtain permission for anyone's image or content you submit. Posts promoting participation for prize eligibility must clearly disclose that connection, such as **#SafeHavenChallenge**.

10. Content, privacy, and platforms. Entrants retain ownership of submitted content and grant Safe Haven a nonexclusive, royalty-free license to reproduce it for Challenge administration and promotion for one year, including reasonable formatting edits. This does not authorize disclosure of confidential survivor information. Subject to law, Safe Haven may publish winners' names, entrant names, hometowns, and prizes. Additional testimonials or unrelated advertising require separate permission.

Information will be used for administration, verification, fulfillment, and legal compliance under Safe Haven's website Privacy Policy. Entry does not automatically enroll anyone in marketing communications.

This promotion is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook, Instagram, Meta, or any other social platform. To the extent permitted by law, entrants release those platforms from claims arising from this promotion.

11. Administration and responsibility. Safe Haven may correct documented errors and disqualify invalid entries, applying these Rules consistently and in good faith. If fraud, outages, disasters, or other circumstances materially compromise fairness, Safe Haven may suspend or modify the affected portion with public notice and use a fair procedure consistent with these Rules. It will not retroactively impose a donation requirement, reduce earned rights, or change the prize funding condition.

Entrants are responsible for lawful, safe participation and accurate contact information. To the extent permitted by law, Safe Haven, its officers, employees, volunteers, and prize providers are not responsible for failures outside their reasonable control or unauthorized third-party conduct. Nothing releases liability for fraud, gross negligence, willful misconduct, or liability or rights that cannot lawfully be waived. Administrative decisions remain subject to Section 12.

12. Dispute resolution and governing law. Safe Haven and each entrant agree to attempt to resolve disputes concerning this Challenge or these Rules informally first. The party raising a dispute must provide written notice describing the issue, relevant facts, and requested resolution. Notices to Safe Haven must be sent to s.c.safehaven@sbcglobal.net; notices to an entrant will be sent to the contact information provided at registration. The parties will make a good-faith effort to resolve the dispute within 30 days after receipt. Safe Haven will not charge a fee for this informal review.

If the dispute remains unresolved, the parties may voluntarily agree to mediation, including by telephone or video, with a mutually selected neutral mediator. The mediator and allocation of mediation costs must be agreed upon in writing before mediation begins. Mediation does not impose a binding outcome unless the parties agree to a settlement.

If the dispute is not settled, either party may bring a claim in a court with appropriate jurisdiction, including small-claims court where the parties and claim are eligible. Alternatively, the parties may agree in a separate written agreement signed after the dispute arises to binding arbitration. That agreement must identify the arbitration provider, applicable rules, location or remote format, and allocation of costs. Accepting these Rules does not require arbitration or waive the right to a court or jury trial where otherwise available.

Nothing in this section prevents either party from making a timely filing to preserve legal rights, seeking urgent court relief, or reporting a matter to a government agency. Informal discussions or mediation do not automatically extend legal filing deadlines. Each party is responsible for its

own attorney fees and costs unless applicable law, a lawful court order, or a subsequent written settlement or dispute-resolution agreement provides otherwise.

Arkansas law governs these Rules, except where applicable federal law or other mandatory law controls. Nothing in these Rules limits rights or remedies that cannot lawfully be waived.

13. Acceptance and severability. Entrants must affirmatively accept these Rules when registering. A donation alone does not constitute registration or acceptance of these Rules. If a provision is found invalid or unenforceable, it will be severed to the extent permitted by law, and the remaining provisions will remain effective.

These Rules and supplemental mini-challenge rules published before the applicable mini challenge begins govern the Challenge, subject to applicable law. Supplemental rules may not override these Rules or retroactively change eligibility, earned points or entries, or prize conditions. Verified winner information may be requested at s.c.safehaven@sbcglobal.net within 90 days after the Challenge ends.
